A. Field Operations Report

- Reinstalled meter at 227 Fir St.
- Raised and adjusted antennas at Sawpit, Middle and Lower Burnt Mill sites.
- Removed dirt from between hillside and fence at Coonturn well 5.
- Replaced two hard to read meters found while meter reading.
- Replaced broken curb stop at 375 Lovers Ln.
- Added 10' of 1" poly to Middle Burnt Mill well 4 at well head.
- Replaced leaking angle stop at 227 Fir St.
- Checked hydrants, hydrant valves, Air Vacs and Blow Offs for leaks. No leaks found.
- Replaced bad/unregistering meter at Coonturn well 5.
- Repaired 3" pumping line that County broke while digging out culverts on Burnt Mill Rd. (535 cubic feet)
- Installed new valve cans for hydrant valves at Mojave River Rd./Kissing Rock and Mojave River Rd./Romnah Rd.
- Replaced pipe and valve can to hydrant at Willow Witch/Lovers Lane.
- Repaired service saddle leak at 201 Nardi Lane. (2,762 cubic feet)
- Installed new service for 21460 Sawpit Canyon Rd.
- Small service line leak repair at 21710 Ridge Dr. (40 cubic feet)
- Replaced sump switch with float switch inside Sawpit sump tank for high sump level alarms. (SCADA)
- Replaced broken concrete meter box lids with steel lids at 21841 Crest Forest Dr. and 22033 Whispering Pines Dr.
- Meter reading 4/21-4/22.
- Starting parts Inventory at shop.
- Extended service line and replaced angle stop at 21833 Fern Canyon Rd.
- Lowered and adjust meter boxes at 21755 Sawpit Canyon Rd. and 21498 Crest Forest Dr.
- Replaced 6" valve lid and can at 21585 Ballenger Rd.
- Replaced old gate valve with new curb stop at 22079 Big Oak Rd.

- Pumped water from weather out of office vault (1' from top of vault) and Waters Dr. vault. (less then 1' from bottom of vault)
- Performed monthly tank inspections and cleaned debris off top of tanks.
- Installed fire hydrant lock on fire hydrant inside County yard.
- Replaced 7 old (1985) meters.
- CLAWA pumps, turned up from 10gpm to 25gpm on 4/1 and up from 25gpm to 40gpm on 4/9. Turned down from 40gpm to 21gpm on 4/13 and down from 21gpm to 10gpm on 4/20. Turned off 4/28.
- Marked out 8 Dig Alert tickets, 5 Edison replacing power poles/anchor and 3 for residents.
- All water samples taken for April and reported to State Water Resources Control Board reveal all samples taken are fine and under MCL.

Domestic Production in April was 205,340 cubic-feet (35.6 gpm). Purchased water (CLAWA) was 113,316 cubic-feet (19.6 gpm), for a total of 318,656 cubic-feet (55.2 gpm) to the system.
